Emilia McCool's **Planning Tips** Tropical

- Decorate with exotic fruit. Incorporate papayas, mangoes and limes. It's even cost-effective.
- Don't take the theme too literally. Adding too many tropical elements can make the event look like a luauthemed party. Skip the fringe skirts.
- Serve tiki cocktails. Hand guests colorful drinks on arrival.
- Play music. Expand the theme to sounds too. Hire a ukulele player or a calypso band.
- Book an appropriate venue. Rustic barns don't work for tropical décor as well as a beach venue does.
